
Get a jump start on 2021! This summer along with some local volunteers we created a Special Foods Workshop video:

Applications for the 2021 Hunting Team are <u>due Friday</u>, <u>November 20</u>, 2020. This is a skills and knowledge based contest that includes animal identification, orienteering, hunting knowledge, and shooting ability (based on 3D Archery, Sporting Clays, and Rifle using paper animal targets). The application can be found at <u>extension.sdstate.edu</u> under 2021 hunting team application. The application and reference letter from your shooting sports coach need to be emailed tomorrow! Please let me know if you are interested and I can assist you in making the deadline.



If you or someone you know interested in becoming a certified 4-H Shooting Sports coach please contact me. Both counties can use volunteers. (The Annual State Shooting Sports meeting scheduled for December 12, 2020 in Pierre has been cancelled.) If you have youth age 8 by January 1, and enrolled in 4-H they are eligible to participate in the 4-H Shooting Sports Programs. Please contact me or the extension office for more information.

Campbell County is planning their first shooting sports meeting at the Mound City Community Center on December 6. We will do safety testing and revisit our Emergency Plan, do an equipment check, and confirm the schedule (a tentative schedule is on the calendar of events page 2 of this newsletter).

Walworth County 4-H shooting sports program is being reviewed and the schedule is being revised so keep watching for more information in the very near future.





The SD Game Fish Parks notified me that Hunt Safe is still available online until further notice. To find the correct location on the GFP web site go to gfp.sd.gov. once there look under the hunt tab, and then hunter education. Hunt Safe is required for youth aged 12-16 who are not participating in a mentored hunt. Also, the SD Game Fish Parks wants everyone to know that they dropped the age minimum for mentor hunting.
