1. Weaving: Learn how to weave using a loom.

2. Painting: Paint on a canvas frame. Learn how to paint a background with a silhouette.

3. Wood sign: Finish a piece of wood and applique words.

4. Glass etching: Learn how to use etching cream to etch a design on glass, or a mirror.

5. Needle felting: Must be at least 10 years of age as needles are super sharp; will use roving wool or yarn with a needle to felt a project.

6. Wooden clothespin cross: Use wooden clothespins to form a cross, finish and detail the wood.

7. Wool Dryer Balls: Using raw fleece and roving make your own dryer balls.

8. Pottery: Make and paint a bowl using self hardening clay.
